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Our time line covers centuries, not decades, so we must learn to think in centuries; we've only just begun. If there is one question we really should be concerned with now, it is the question of how we can continue doing Theosophical work, and how each of the traditions could play an active role in this and finally how International Theosophy Conferences can bring all of us together. By doing the work unconditionally, respectfully in oneness, breaking new grounds, each of the groups and all independent Theosophists will come up with answers.

As we do the work, all our doubts will eventually ebb away.
